

TVA in Virginia

ENERGY SALES

- In fiscal year 2003, TVA sold more than 76 million kilowatt-hours of electricity to the Bristol Tennessee Electric System and the Powell Valley Electric Cooperative to serve four counties in southwestern Virginia.
- Distributors of TVA power provided electricity to more than 6,400 Virginia households in fiscal year 2003, with sales of approximately 8.8 million kilowatt-hours.
- Distributors of TVA power served approximately 1,100 commercial and industrial Virginia customers in fiscal year 2003, with sales of more than 40 million kilowatt-hours. In addition, distributors in Virginia sold over three million kilowatt-hours to outdoor lighting customers.
- TVA also sold almost 8.845 million kilowatt-hours directly to large industries in Virginia.
- TVA revenues from Virginia distributors and industrial customers totaled \$3.7 million in fiscal year 2003.

SERVICE AREA

- TVA serves Lee and Scott Counties and small portions of Washington and Wise Counties in Virginia.
- The TVA service area in Virginia covers 1,941 square miles.

POWER GENERATION AND TRANSMISSION

- A nine-kilowatt solar-energy facility at Duffield-Pattonsville Elementary School in Scott County became operational in fiscal year 2001.
- TVA owns and/or maintains one substation and five miles of transmission line in Virginia.

LAND AND WATER STEWARDSHIP

- The upper half of South Holston Reservoir extends into Virginia. This 7,580-acre reservoir features beautiful mountain scenery and cool, clear waters that draw recreation visitors from a wide area.
- TVA has conveyed several thousand acres of land to other public entities, including Washington County, Virginia, for recreation purposes, and it also manages a day-use park that offers picnicking, walking trails, and fishing accommodations at South Holston Dam Reservation. Several commercial marinas also provide recreation facilities and services on the reservoirs.



PERSONNEL

- Virginia is home to more than 120 TVA retirees and their families.

TAX-EQUIVALENT PAYMENTS

- TVA paid \$104,245 in lieu of taxes to the State of Virginia in 2003, based on power sales and power property values in the state.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

- Since 1996, TVA Economic Development has invested \$1.5 million in economic development loans for new industries in Virginia. These loans have helped create 625 jobs and leveraged \$107.5 million in investments from other sources.

TVA SUPPLIERS

- TVA purchases from Virginia vendors totaled \$193.5 million in fiscal year 2003, including \$15.8 million in materials and services, \$134.3 million in fossil fuel, and \$43.4 million in nuclear fuel.
